Full guidance can be found in the Behaviour for Learning Policy Rutlish School - Policies & Procedures and Rutlish School - Uniform</p> <p>Key points to note are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes - Sensible plain black shoes: no trainers or leisure/canvas shoes • Coats - Plain outdoor/waterproof coat: hooded sweatshirts and tracksuit tops are not acceptable as coats.
