For our conference, each year we host a range of world-leading speakers on topical and significant issues. This year's conference theme is 'Politics Reshaped: Navigating the Age of Populism' and includes three panel discussions on:

The main conference will run from **12.45pm to 5.30pm** but will include breaks between the three sessions, each of which will include speeches and a Q&A element. The interactive workshop will run separately from **10am to 11.30am**. We are delighted to relaunch a workshop that will take place immediately before the conference, aimed at introducing sixth-form students (prioritising those from the state sector) to the world of public policy. These workshops will allow the students to try their hand at crafting real-world, actionable policies in response to the conference themes, in groups led by current Cambridge undergraduates.

Not only will the conference introduce students to topical social and political issues, but there will also be a chance to informally discuss Cambridge life and applications with current students during the small-group portion of the workshop.
