<p>YEAR 7</p>	<p>YEAR 8</p> <p>UKMT JUNIOR MATHS CHALLENGE</p> <p>Congratulations to all Rutlish students who entered The United Kingdom Mathematics Trust (UKMT) runs a series of challenges each year to inspire a love of problem solving through its competitions and enrichment activities. Earlier this month, 227 students from Years 7 and 8 took part in the UKMT Junior Maths Challenge. A record 65% of the students received awards, with 16 students achieving Gold, putting them in the top 8% of entrants nationally. 47 students received Silver and a further 84 received Bronze certificates.</p> <p>Nine students scored so highly that they qualified for the follow-on Kangaroo round.
