GCSE and Vocational Grades

I am pleased to report that all GCSE and vocational grades have now been submitted to the exam boards. The exam boards will use these centre assessed grades and standardise the results so that they are comparable with previous years. The school is not involved in this process and we will discover the outcome of this standardisation in August.

Autumn exams

Ofqual has now finished its consultation on an autumn exam series and we await the final decisions. A degree of caution needs to be applied when trying to anticipate what the exam boards will do. However, you should be aware that it is possible that the retake opportunity may be in late October & November. As part of the consultation they anticipated that the half term break in October could be problematic as these dates can vary from school to school and we may find that some exams are scheduled to take place in half term. As soon as they publish the outcomes of the consultation we will contact you.

Results Collection

GCSE results are scheduled to be released to students on Thursday 20th August. We will write to you in July to outline the arrangements for the results collection as it is likely we will have to implement social distance measures on the day which may result in students being given set times to collect their results.
