# **Y6 TRANSITION**

Thank you for your patience and understanding whilst we navigate the transition from KS2 to KS3 under the changing government guidance. This letter is one of significant length but contains all of the vital information you will need prior to your child's move into secondary school. #### INDUCTION EVENTS

#### CATs (Cognitive Ability Tests)

We have considered the risk of administering these tests in the summer term in line with the current government guidance. After much consideration, we have decided that there is still significant risk when bringing in students from various 'bubbles' and therefore CATs tests will be done in the Autumn Term during the normal school day.

Pending Government guidance, we are preparing to hold an Induction Day in school on 7<sup>th</sup> July; we will confirm this after half term. Irrespective of summer events, our new Year 7 students will be invited for a full induction day in the autumn term on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> September.



# Summer School – Monday 9th August – Friday 13th August (9am – 2.45pm)

We will be running a Summer School during the summer holidays. All students who are joining us in Year 7 from September are welcome to register to attend. Summer School activities will include sessions from curriculum areas such as science and media, as well as sport, performing arts and mental health and wellbeing. #### **Communications with Parents/Carers**

Rutlish communicate with parents/carers via 'School Gateway' a service which allows the school to share information quickly via email, text, online and smartphone app. It also saves you and the school time and money. ## Cashless Catering System

The school operate a cashless system in the school canteen, please see pages 35-36 in the Transition Handbook, information can also be found on the school website Rutlish School - School Meals. You login details will be emailed to you at the beginning of the autumn term.

For the first few days of the autumn term please send your child to school with a packed lunch, this is just in case of technical issues when registering the students. Students will be registered for their biometric fingerprints during induction day (consent to biometrics was part of the ICT Agreement forms that were emailed to you at the beginning of May).

## **Pupil Premium**

The Pupil Premium grant is paid to schools for the purpose of increasing the aspirations and attainment of students from disadvantaged backgrounds. The money the school receives is based on the students who are recorded as being eligible for Free School Meals in the last six years, who are 'Looked After' or who have a parent serving in the armed forces.
