## Dear Parent/Carer

This will allow us to process the query efficiently and ensure it is passed to the relevant staff. For any urgent issues please contact the school by phone during normal school hours.

Since my last communication, there have been a variety of updates shared by the exam boards and Ofqual which are detailed below. However, it is important to recognise that not all details have been clarified e.g. the consultation of awarding vocational qualifications is not due to finish until the 8<sup>th</sup> May.

## **Exam Board Updates**

- Previously it was suggested that students would receive their results in late July. It has now been confirmed that results will be published on the 20<sup>th</sup> August 2020.
- Ofqual have confirmed that students studying a vocational course will also receive a calculated grade. The
  fine detail of this process is still awaiting clarification as students completing these courses have already
  taken some external assessments.
- Exam boards will start to collect the centre assessed grades from the 1st June.

Staff are currently working on providing the centre assessed grades to the exam boards based on the evidence we have. I can reassure you that this is a rigorous process with the grades being scrutinized by several staff to ensure all students receive a fair grade from the school.

However, it is important to note that the centre assessed grade is not the final grade and the exam board will review the grades awarded to ensure they are in line with the school's prior performance and the national distribution of grades is the same as last year. This process could lead to several grades being altered.

In line with Ofqual's requirements, can I request that staff are not contacted to discuss the grades awarded as this would be regarded as malpractice and would need to be reported to the exam boards.

If your son has not applied to a college/6<sup>th</sup> form careers support is still available. If you would like to access this support, please contact me through the administration email and we will arrange for our careers advisor to contact you by telephone.
