WHOLE SCHOOL	Covid19 On Monday, the Prime Minister set out the next phase of the government's Covid-19 response, 'Living with Covid-19'. The DfE emailed schools and colleges with details on what this means for education settings: Testing Testing Testing Term Friday 1 April, the government will no longer provide free to order universal symptomatic and asymptomatic testing for the general public in England. Students will no longer receive LFT test kits from school (though this may change if there is a local outbreak) All staff and students will continue to be able to access test kits from their local pharmacy or online. Anyone with symptoms should take a PCR test, stay at home and follow government guidance if positive.
	 From Thursday 24 February, the government will remove the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test. However, adults and children who test positive will continue to be advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least five full days, and then continue to follow the guidance until they have received two negative test results on consecutive days. Routine contact tracing will end. Fully vaccinated close contacts and those aged under 18 will no longer be asked to test daily for seven days, and close contacts who are not fully vaccinated will no longer be required to self-isolate. We are keen to keep school as safe as possible, and request that students follow the guidelines above and stay at home if they have a positive test.
