YEARS 7, 11, 12 and 13

Thank you for your continued engagement in the Covid-19 testing programme. Please continue to encourage your child to test twice weekly and report the results here [Rutlish Home Test Results](#) as well as on the NHS website [Report a COVID-19 rapid lateral flow test result - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](#) If you would like further LFD test kits your child is able to pick a box up from the Manor House next week.

The school will be carrying out lateral flow testing for all students at the start of the Spring Term, as announced by the Government.

COVID TESTING IN SCHOOL

Your child's testing day will be **Wednesday 5 January 2022**. Please make sure your child attends at the time stated below.

If your child has had a positive PCR test within 90 days of their test date in January, they are exempt from having to take a lateral flow test.

Students not taking part in testing do not need to attend school on test day, however, they will have to attend their on-line lessons, (please see overleaf).

Students:

- must arrive at the Watery Lane entrance and will be directed to the Hall
- wear a face covering (unless exempt)
- should not arrive earlier than the time given
- can wear their own clothes
- return straight home once their test is completed to attend their on-line lessons (please see below).

Consent:

- If you have not previously given consent for your child to be tested and you now wish to do so, please complete the form [Rutlish Consent Form](#)

- If you have already given consent, there is no need to re-consent and your child can attend at the time below.
- If you wish to withdraw your consent, please complete [Withdrawal Consent Form](#).

Test result:

Parents/carers and students will be informed as soon as possible (usually within 30 minutes) if the student has tested positive or if the test was void.

For students with a positive result parents/carers will need to arrange for a PCR test to confirm the result: [Get a free PCR test to check if you have coronavirus \(COVID-19\) - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](#).

While students wait for the PCR result they will need to self-isolate. Students can return to school if the result is negative. If the result of this PCR test is positive, the student and household members will need to follow Government guidelines.

Students will be given a home test kit to use from Sunday 9 January.


We recommend testing on a Sunday and Wednesday evening or Monday and Thursday morning and continue this routine throughout the Spring Term.
