Covid cases	We are writing to inform you that we have had more than a few positive cases of COVID-19 in Year 7. We know that you may find this concerning, but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with the Health Protection Team at Public Health Merton. This letter is to inform you of the current situation and provide advice on how to support your child. Please be reassured that, for most people, it will be a mild illness.
	The school setting remains open and your child should continue to attend if they remain well. All parents are advised to continue with the routine 3 times a week asymptomatic Lateral Flow Device COVID-19 testing of those aged 11 and above in the household.
	Rest assured that we are following all the government guidelines; we are encouraging good hygiene amongst all our students and staff, we are keeping occupied spaces well ventilated and we are maintaining an appropriate cleaning regime. In addition, we are following public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19.
